Equipment Relocation from Belle Chasse to Venice Louisiana:

Clean Gulf Associates (CGA) sustained damage to the Fort Jackson Base as a result of hurricane Katrina. You were notified in May of 2006 that equipment formally located at Fort Jackson was moved to Belle Chasse, Louisiana.

CGA has now reestablished a base in the Venice area and it is located in the USES facility approximately two miles north of Venice. The following equipment has been relocated to that facility from Belle Chasse:

One Marco Skimmer
Two Fast Response Units
One Oil Storage Barge 249 bbl
Six Drums of Corexit 9527
Two Sets of 12 Bird Scare Guns

Equipment Relocation from Pascagoula, Miss. To Belle Chasse Louisiana:

One Fast Response Unit now located in Pascagoula, Miss. Will be relocated to Belle Chasse Louisiana effective February 16, 2007.

Equipment Removal from Service

The following equipment has been removed from service due to lack of use and high maintenance cost:

Communications Trailer located in Lake Charles, Louisiana
Biological and Chemical Testing Trailer located in Lake Charles Louisiana

Four 50 bbl oil storage barges have been removed from service and replaced with two 249 bbl aluminum storage barges located in Houma and Venice Louisiana.

Equipment Modifications

Five of the nine Fast Response Units have been modified by adding a hydraulically driven pump inside the floating Don Wilson Skimmer. This modification has greatly added to the efficiency of the unit by eliminating the difficulties in maintaining prim as well as increasing the derated skimming capacity. These five units are now called the FRU Model Five and the derated skimming capacity has been increased from 3400 bbls per day to 3770 bbls per day.

The five FRU Model 5 units are located at the following bases:

Galveston
Venice
Lake Charles
Belle Chasse
Ingleside

The other four FRU's are located at the following bases:

Houma 3 Units
Venice 1 Unit.
